

Welcome to the 2023 St. Juan Diego Collegiate Awards

The Catholic Media Association invites Students and Alumni Magazines to participate in the 2023 St. Juan Diego Collegiate Awards competition. St. Juan Diego is a symbol of evangelization and the messenger of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This newly named program, formerly known as the Student Journalism and Alumni Magazine awards, honors media that embodies goodwill, compassion, and uplifting spirit.

For Students, the program provides aspiring journalists and media professionals a critique of your work and introduces you to hundreds of journalism and communications professionals from throughout North America.

This competition is ideal for students looking to become media professionals. Award winners earn recognition that enhances résumés, and potentially earn internships while still in school. Judges evaluate the entry as if it were being submitted to an editor or communications director, and each entry receives a constructive critique.

For Alumni Magazines, this program adds recognition to your work and enhances the visibility of your university and alumni.

Please check with your funding sources to see if your college/university or department is available to support your participation. Thank you for considering the Catholic Media Association's St. Juan Diego Collegiate Awards.

Awards are presented at the Catholic Media Conference, June 6-9, 2023, in Baltimore, and announced in The Catholic Journalist with comments from judges, as well as on the CMA website and on social media.

Background Basics

Awards Website

- All judging for the Catholic Media Awards will take place in our awards website **<https://catholicpress.secure-platform.com/a/solicitations/46/home>**. On this website, you can view all of your judging assignments, score entries, add comments, and choose winning entries.
- **Returning judges:** Log onto the website using the same email and password as last year. If you do not remember your password, click the “lost password?” link to reset it.
- **New judges:** A profile has already been created for you in our system. Before judging opens on March 1, 2023 you will receive an email that automatically assigns a password to your account. Use this password to log in, update your profile, and evaluate entries. You are encouraged to create your own password once logged in.

Hard Copy Submissions

Specific categories require the participant to submit a “Hard Copy” so that judges can review the actual product. The CMA office ships those copies to the judge if assigned a hard copy category in late February. Scoring is still done online for that category.

Placement and Comment Updates

Judges may award up to five winners per category, a First, Second, Third, and two Honorable Mentions. Awards must be given in consecutive order. Honorable Mentions are not required, use only if you feel it is merited, and positions 1-3 are assigned.

Judges must provide comments for First, Second, and Third place winners. The comments are read by all participants and should include two to three sentences that summarize why the entry won.

Disqualification

The CMA office does its best to run interference on entries that are incomplete or ineligible. Due to the high volume of entries, sometimes ineligible submissions get through. You have full authority to disqualify an entry for the following reasons:

- Incorrect number of elements (i.e., submitting one article where three are required)
- Content was not published in 2022
- Content submitted does not match category description

To disqualify an entry, state the reason in an email to establish an official record of the decision. CMA office staff will remove the entry from your assignments and keep a record of the reason. Email to

Judging Process

1. Access your assignments.

- A. From the homepage of the awards website, enter your email and password to log in. Once you are in,
- B. Click “My Judging Assignments.”
- C. Click “Open” on the line that indicates the 2023 Catholic Media Awards.
- D. Click “Open” again on the line that says “View All Categories.”
 - i. All of your assigned submissions will show up. You can filter your submissions by category and status (scored or un-scored) in the sidebar on the right side of the screen.

2. Evaluating an entry.

- A. Click “View Application” next to an entry that you wish to judge.
 - i. You will see two columns: the application on the left and the evaluation form on the right.
- B. Clicking “Next” at the end of the Applicant Information will pull up the Submission Form, which will have file uploads, URLs, and other information necessary to judge the submission.
 - i. You can click back and forth between the Applicant Information and Submission Form and the Evaluation Form will stay where it is.

After evaluating the entry, you have two options

1. Stop Working: Click **“Save and Back to List”**
 - i. This saves your work and takes you back to the list of your assignments, where you log out
2. Continue working: Click **“Save and Go to Next”**
 - i. This allows you to go straight to the next entry to be judged

3. Editing judgments. You have until **11:59 am Central Time on April 7, 2023, to make changes.**

- A. To change the score of an entry, search for it using the filters on the right side of the screen, then click “View Application.” Change scores as you see fit. Be sure to save your changes.

4. Assigning winners. Judges may award up to five winners per category, a First, Second, Third, and two Honorable Mentions. Honorable Mention is to be used for entries that did not quite merit a Third-place position. Awards must be given in consecutive order so that Honorable Mention is used only if places 1-3 are filled, and only if you feel it is merited, it is not required.

Judges must provide comments for all First, Second, and Third place winners. The comments are read by all participants and should include a few positive sentences that summarize why the entry won.
